Director's Message

'Change certainly is the theme of TPAS Cymru for this financial year'

Firstly, we have seen changes in the TPAS Cymru staff team. We have said farewell to 2 members of staff who have chosen to take other paths. On behalf of the team I would like to thank Nina and Clair for all their hard work and commitment over the years. As well as staff departures, I was delighted to be appointed as Director mid-point through this financial year and we will have a new Project Officer in south Wales very soon.

Significant change in the sector is noticeable and we are listening and reacting swiftly. We are continually looking at value for money and we have undertaken a review in consultation with members to reorganise our events, training and networks. I'm sure you will agree that the feedback from our revised Network events has been very positive.

'Another area of change is models of tenant participation'.

We are seeing exciting work emerge in Co-production and Co-operative housing, which open up new ways for

tenants voices to be heard and respected in co-designing services. This really excites me about the future of tenant participation.

You will see in this report a positive position regarding our financial performance. Cost cutting was certainly a theme of my first 6 months in the role and the figures reflect that. Continuing this level of cost cutting is not sustainable going forward, but we recognise that Social Housing finance is stretched in particular tenant participation budgets, and we expect further reductions in Welsh Government funding.

On behalf of the team, I would like to thank the Board for their support during this period and the input and direction they have given in guiding TPAS Cymru and tenant participation forward.
